## *Fast Facts*

The following fact sheet will help you answer questions you may receive from visitors to Prince Albert National Park.

### Waskesiu Community Hall Restoration

1. Parks Canada Agency is restoring the Waskesiu Community Hall, a federally recognized heritage building, to preserve its cultural heritage.
2. **Restoration is underway**
  - **The roof is approximately 80% complete**
  - **The basement crawlspace is complete**
  - **The stone mason working on fireplace and stonework**
3. **The project is expect to be completed by the end of June 2007.**
4. **We will do our best to carry out construction around events taking place in the building.**
5. Parks Canada and Public Works put the project out to tender during the summer of 2006 (late August). No tenders were received. Consequently, the project was sole sourced tendered, with the construction starting in mid-December 2006.
6. The recapitalization project includes \$250,000 in funding for:
  - Renewal of roofing and shingles, elimination of bat access to rafters
  - Replacement of insulation in basement
  - Preparation of exterior wood siding and application of new stain/paint
  - Tree trimming for mould control on cedar shingles
