Trailer Park Sewer and Water Infrastructure Project **Autumn 2007**

Fees at work!

1. Parks Canada is investing in upgrades in the Trailer Park, a project made possible by visitor fee increases.
2. The Trailer Park closed early this fall – closure begins Monday September 3, 2007.
3. The early closure is to facilitate the construction project that involves:
 - waterline infrastructure improvements/upgrades in Loops A-F
 - service connection replacement in Loops A-F
 - sanitary sewer upgrades in Loops G-H
4. To accommodate visitors looking for the townsite camping experience, additional loops are open in Beaver Glen campground.
5. \$600,000 is allocated for the project, and is funded by revenue collected from fee increases.
6. Anticipated completion date: November 23, 2007.
7. A tender process was completed and the contract awarded to Ruszkowski Enterprises.
