In 2003, the Waskesiu Community Council, in collaboration with Parks Canada, developed a Community Vegetation Management Strategy. One of the recommendations of the strategy was to hold an Annual Arbor Day - a celebration where people from the community work together to plant native trees representative of the surrounding boreal forest.

In 2003, in commemoration of Prince Albert National Park's 75th Anniversary, 75 trees were planted in the townsite. In 2004, 150 trees were planted. Thanks to volunteers who helped take care of the new trees!
